Getting to the venue

If coming by train, the nearest station is Newcastle Central Station which is a 0.5-mile walk.

If coming directly from the *airport*, you can get a metro to Monument, from where it is a 0.5 mile walk to the venue, or you can change at Monument to go to St James, which is 0.3 miles from the venue.

If you are coming by car, the nearest car park is The Garage of the Newcastle Helix, NE4 5QB (please note charges will apply).
